**Today's chancel choir anthem is by the renowned African  
American (and Candian) composer, R. Nathaniel Dett  
(1882-1943).** Born in Ontario, Dett studied at Oberlin Con-  
servatory and later taught at the Hampton Institute of Virgin-  
ia. Adolphus Hailstork (b1941), prolific African American  
composer and professor of music at Old Dominion University,

is the author of this morning's somewhat avant-garde organ postlude.

**Please join us at 7:00 pm on Saturday, February 26, 2011, for a musical celebration of Black History Month entitled, Let Justice Roll.** The concert will be held in the Sanctuary and feature the Christ Church of Summit Chancel & Youth Choirs and the Good News Community Choir (under the direction of Mark Miller), as well as several guest musicians. The repertoire will be by African American composers including Richard Smallwood, Nathaniel Dett, and Miller himself. Miller has set two poems of Langston Hughes to music and has composed a larger work based on Martin Luther King's Letter from a Birmingham Jail. This featured composition will be narrated by the Reverend Dr. James Forbes, Pastor Emeritus of The Riverside Church in New York City. All in the community are welcome. The cost of tickets is a minimum donation of \$15/person or \$25/family to help support the music ministry of the church.
