**May 7:** Your donations of gently used household goods are eagerly awaited and deeply appreciated by our partner groups in Nicaragua. Please bring donations to the church parking lot from 9 a.m. to noon. Place items in cardboard boxes; tape to each box a removable label stating contents.

Tax receipt is available. Kindly help PeaceWorks with shipping costs by dropping into the kitty \$5 or more for each cardboard box\_you bring.

In high demand are summer-weight clothing and shoes, male and female, all ages (but remember no one has feet larger than women's size 8.5, men's 10.5); pots & pans; linens and towels; school/office supplies; gardening implements; sports equipment; and toys, including a special request for hula hoops and Razor-type scooters. Washing machines and other large items are also welcome.
