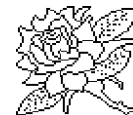

Note on the Prelude: This morning's prelude, *Fantasia for Pentecost*, was the first organ piece Mark wrote as a sophomore in high school. He was organist for his Father's church in Union Village and one morning one of the contacts wasn't working on the organ keyboard. "I was trying to get the dust out of this one key- I kept hitting very fast to get the note working. I added some chords to what I was playing, and a composition started taking shape!" He composes glissandos and chord arpeggios hoping the listener can imagine the tongues of fire and the rushing wind of that first Pentecost.
