Runaway children who live on the streets just lie down and sleep on a piece of cardboard or the bare ground, without so much as a sheet to cover them. If you happen to have a portable bed, such as a **folding cot**, that you no longer use, that too would also be a welcome donation. At Inhijambia, the street children's rehabilitation center in Managua, it's the lucky child who goes home at night to sleep in a bed of his/her own: usually there's a sibling or two, and maybe also a parent, under the same covers. Loading day for the PeaceWorks container shipment is Saturday, May 5, but **early donations are welcome**.
