All: Because all are made in God's image, and all are made poorer when they are left out.



SOS: Today's SOS Moment is being led by Jeannette Brown, who is active in HomeSharing, Inc., an organization supported by Christ Church through the Board of World Fellowship. HomeSharing uses a home sharing model to help prevent homelessness. The organization matches "providers," residents who can share their homes or apartments, with "seekers," individuals who need affordable housing in the community. These matches foster independence with dignity. HomeSharing began in Somerset County but is now also active in Union, Morris, Middlesex and Hunterdon counties. During coffee hour today, you are invited to meet with Jeannette and the director to learn more about HomeSharing.

Each year during Lent, the Board of World Fellowship asks the congregation to consider supporting **SOS**, **Sundays of Sharing**, by making a special gift for outreach. The BWF uses the SOS funds to supplement the moneys received from the Christ Church annual budget. These funds are used to respond to emergencies, like Hurricane Sandy, as
