An online survey was then conducted. The e-board considered the results of that survey and felt that two options should be retained for a congregational vote. Either sell Stony Hill Court and rebuild on New England Avenue or simply sell New England Avenue.

The e-board feels that both of the final two options are reasonable and wishes to give the congregation an opportunity to express its collective will in a formal vote on April 6^{th} after the 9:30 service. There will be no 11:15 service that day.

Organizing CERT Team in Summit: The City of Summit Office of Emergency Management Police and Fire Departments are establishing a Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) and recruiting volunteer participants for the eight-week training program on Monday evenings in March and April.

The goal is to educate volunteers about disaster preparedness and train them in basic disaster response skills, such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization, and disaster medical operations. CERT members will also help with non-emergency projects to improve community safety.

CERT training is free and open to all Summit residents age 16 and older. The 20-hours of training are classroom based with few physical requirements.
